Now the jingle hop has begun.

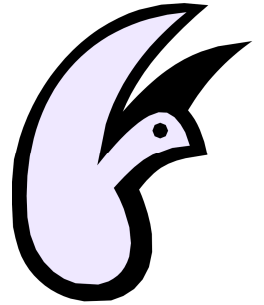
Jingle bell, jingle bell, jingle bell rock
