Guidelines

A reading log will be sent home every month in your child's blue folder. Please record all the books and the number of pages that your child read. You may also include books that a parent, a sibling, or any other person has read to him/her. You may also include non-English books. Please do not include books that are read during story time in school or library. Also, please do not include books that are read to your child from a pre-recorded tape or CD (read-along books). A parent's signature is required on each log turned in. Please remember to write your child's name on the reading log so we can keep a running tally of the number of pages your child has read.

The reading logs should be turned in with the blue folder on the last Monday of the month or whenever specified by the reading log. When your child has read 1,000 pages or more, he/she will receive a prize and a certificate of congratulations for becoming a member of the Thousand Page Club. Once he/she is a member, your child will always be a member for the rest of the school year.

Prizes are awarded during the second week of each month. Any member who turns in a reading log will receive a prize, regardless of the sum total of pages read. Once your child has become a member, he/she will not have to read another 1,000 pages to receive a prize. Just as long as a reading log is turned in, a member will receive a prize.

At the end of the year, your child will be invited to a members-only assembly. Previous assemblies have included acrobats, magicians, animal shows, and ice cream socials. Only children who have read more than 1,000 pages total will be invited to this assembly.
