Students choosing to enter a problem solving experiment are encouraged to refer the Grade 4–6 documents below. Students will receive a “Young Scientist” ribbons and a certificate of participation.

Grades 4–6: may enter a problem solving experiment that utilizes the scientific method. Students will receive a place ribbon and a certificate of participation.
